Agenda Item	Discussion
Pediatric Readiness Hospital Recognition	The EMSC Advisory Committee reviewed Madison Health to be recognized at the Pediatric Advanced level. Dr. Sempsrott spoke to the case reviews and Stacy Connolly went over the onsite review report. The committee approved Madison Health's ED to be recognized as pediatric ready at the Pediatric Advanced level for three years with recognition expiring on 2/18/2028.
EMSC Update	Stacy Connolly updated committee members of the following: The EMSC newsletter continues to be on hold until further notice. SIM-MT began performing pediatric mobile simulations in January. They will complete seven total events at Madison Health, Fremont County Ambulance, Bear Lake Memorial, Cassia Regional, North Canyon Medical Center, St. Luke's McCall, and Bingham Memorial. The scenario will be trauma based with implementation of a child with autism and the Carter Sensory bags will be utilized in the simulations. EMSC is partnering again with the HPP program who will provide funding for the 2025 edition of Broselow tapes to be distributed to prehospital agencies and hospitals throughout the state. The next meeting is on April 10 th which will be in person and all day. Stacy advised members from outside of the Treasure Valley to inform her if they plan to attend so that travel arrangements can be made. The EMSC/St. Luke's Children's conference is on hold and will not be hosted in April of this year, but may possibly be hosted later in 2025. Stacy advised that the development of the prehospital pediatric readiness recognition program will resume at the in person meeting in April.
