AGENDA ITEM	DISCUSSION
EMSC Update	Stacy Rodgers, EMSC Program Manager, advised the committee that the subgrant contract has been executed with SIM-MT for pediatric mobile simulations and that four events have been scheduled in regions 1, 2 and 3 in February and March. Stacy advised members that the 2025 Edition of Broselow Tapes have been recalled and to discontinue use. Stacy has not been informed when a reprint will occur or what will happen with reordering tapes. Stacy informed the committee that the NPRP assessment will be open for hospital ED's to participate on March 3, 2026. She is advising about the NPRP at meetings and will begin emailing EDs soon. Stacy announced upcoming conferences for ISU Emergency Medicine Conference in Pocatello on Feb 27-28, Spring Fling EMS Conference in Grangeville on March 7-8, and Saint Alphonsus EMS Conference in Boise on April 16-17.
Pediatric Ready Marketing Logos	Members were presented with three different designs to vote on for the Idaho Pediatric Readiness Recognition marketing logos for both the hospital and EMS agency recognition programs. These logos can be used by hospitals and EMS agencies when they advertise their pediatric recognition on social media, in newsletters, or with news media, etc.
Pediatric Decision Rule Cards	The committee discussed the pediatric decision rule cards and voted on a design as well as formatting. The final cards will be given to hospital ED's which will have a QR code linked to the EMSC website where they can find a list of decision tools to utilize.

Hospital Pediatric Recognition Program	Stacy gave an update on the hospital pediatric recognition program and advised there are currently 7 hospitals recognized with an anticipated 5 additional hospitals for 2026.
Prehospital Pediatric Recognition Program	The committee decided that surveys will be conducted in person by the EMSC Program Manager who will ensure the EMS agency has the proper equipment and policies in place. Stacy presented the survey report sheet and a rough draft of the prehospital recognition application to the committee for feedback. She will send the draft of the application to Rodney and Cameo to further review for any changes.
Next Meeting Agenda	Stacy informed members that the next meeting will be held in person, all day on Thursday, April 9, 2026, in Boise at St. Luke's Plaza. She will reach out to the members who are traveling outside of the Treasure Valley in mid-February to make travel arrangements.
