Member Announcements	Committee members announced upcoming trainings that will be held in December 2025
EMSC Update	Stacy Rodgers, EMSC Program Manager, advised the committee to submit ideas for the January Newsletter's "Featured Education". She also advised of the upcoming Ski & Mountain Conference in Sun Valley that will be held November 5-7. An RFP will be posted in November to have four Pediatric Mobile simulation events. Stacy will announce the organization and areas that hold these events in the near future. Broselow tape have been shipped and will be distributed to EMS agencies and hospitals who utilize them. All Carter Kits ordered have been distributed, however, Stacy was informed that the free replacement kit is only for EMS. She has decided not to order additional bags at this time. Stacy advised members of the Emergency Information Form that is utilized for children with special needs. Stacy plans to contact the Idaho Chapter of the AAP to see if they are actively using these forms.
Pediatric Decision Rule Cards	Dr. Sempstrott brought an idea to the committee to create Pediatric Decision Rule Cards. This would be sent to all hospitals where they can scan a QR code and be taken to a resource list on the Idaho EMSC website to find the decision tools for various topics. The committee determined which topics should be listed and April Noller volunteered to help find the proper resources for the website.

Hospital Pediatric Recognition Program	There are 7 hospitals recognized with 5 hospitals applying in 2026. Stacy continues to reach out to hospitals to encourage them to become pediatric ready.
Prehospital Pediatric Recognition Program	The committee worked on the verification process for the prehospital recognition program. Members voted to have the program roll out May 2026 during EMS week.
