North-Central Region – Jason Taylor Jason Taylor shared at the last regional meeting, Dr. Parker Fillmore presented on the Idaho TSE Brain Injury Guidelines. The committee established the QI Subcommittee to review TSE (trauma, stroke, and heart attack) cases. Southwest Region – Dr. Parker Fillmore Dr. Parker Fillmore shared the next regional committee meeting will be Thursday, April 17th. South-Central Region – Fran Jamison Fran Jamison shared the committee is preparing to provide medical volunteer support for the upcoming Magic Valley Airshow event in August. The committee voted on new regional officers: Fran Jamison as Chair and Stephanie Shawver as Secretary and is looking to for an EMS provider to fill the Vice-Chair position. Southeast Region – Dr. Curtis Sandy Dr. Curtis Sandy shared at the last regional meeting, the committee was educated on a stroke case review. Portneuf Medical Center is hosting EMS Night Out Tuesday, April 15th, to educate healthcare providers on <i>Stroke Thrombectomy in Rural America</i>. East Region – Eric Day Eric Day shared at the last regional meeting, the committee was educated on a STEMI case view and discussed the process to carry whole blood on ambulances.

TSE System	Melissa Ball shared the annual facility report cards that includes trauma, stroke, and STEMI data and benchmarking metrics will be distributed by end of April. The Statewide Program Manager meetings for Trauma, Stroke, and STEMI will be held at least quarterly to discuss challenges, standards and rolling out initiatives and projects. The Bureau of EMS, including the TSE and EMSC Programs, will transition into the Idaho Military Division effective on July 1 st . Lastly, the Idaho Yellow Dot Program statute remains active, and the Idaho Department of Health & Welfare will designate a new program to provide oversight.
EMSC Program	Stacy Connolly shared the next EMS for Children Advisory Committee meeting is Thursday, April 10 th , and will develop the criteria to create the Prehospital Pediatric Readiness Recognition Program based on results of the PPRP assessment. The EMSC Program will be receiving a few more applications from facilities to become recognize as pediatric ready. Lastly, the EMSC Program will receive the new 2025 edition Broselow tapes by end of April to distribute to facilities and EMS agencies.
TSE Public Education Resource Packet	The TSE Program staff shared the TSE Public Education Packet can be used by hospital and EMS healthcare providers distribute various educational materials to inform their community about time sensitive emergencies and adult and pediatric injury prevention.
