

TSE EMS PERFORMANCE GOALS

****All metrics must be documented in PCR**

ALL

Notify the receiving facility of trauma, stroke, and STEMI

TRAUMA

On scene times less than 15 minutes for full trauma activations*

STEMI

Aspirin administration within 10 minutes of patient contact for suspected MI*

Acquisition of a 12-lead ECG within 10 minutes of patient contact for suspected MI, *if agency performs ECG*

On scene times less than 15 minutes for suspected MI*

STROKE

Use of a stroke scale on patients with primary impression of CVA

For ILS and ALS, also perform LVO assessment

“Last Known Well” time for patients with primary impression of CVA

Obtain blood glucose level in suspected stroke patients

On scene times less than 15 minutes for stroke activations*

**On scene times are applicable for transport agencies only*

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
