Idaho Statute Title 74 Chapter “(d) To consider records that are exempt from disclosure as provided in Chapter 1, Title 74, Idaho Code;”. During the Executive Session, the Idaho TSE Council took no action. Dr. Parker Fillmore made a motion to exit the Executive Session. Brad Huerta spoke in support of the motion. Motion passed.

TSE Regional Reports	North Region – Amanda Pringle Amanda Pringle shared at the last regional meeting, the committee analyzed the region’s trauma volumes and real-time data processes and discussed the utilization of warming devices for cardiac arrest. North-Central Region – Jason Taylor Jason Taylor shared at the last regional meeting, the committee analyzed regional and statewide data and identified gaps in coordination of care in rural EMS. The next regional meeting will be Tuesday, September 16th. Southwest Region – Dr. Parker Fillmore Dr. Parker Fillmore shared at the last regional meeting, the committee discussed in-depth their bylaws and committee representation especially EMS. The committee held election for a new officer, Heather Knapp as Secretary. The next regional meeting will be Thursday, August 21st. South-Central Region – Toni Jackson Toni Jackson shared at the last regional meeting, the committee discussed hosting Triage Tuesdays quarterly now to expand the education opportunity to more healthcare providers. The next regional meeting will be Wednesday, September 10th. Southeast Region – Dr. Curtis Sandy Dr. Curtis Sandy shared the next regional meeting will be Wednesday, September 24th, and the committee will be conducting elections for a new secretary officer. East Region – Jim Jarvie Jim Jarvie shared at the last regional meeting, the committee discussed in-depth the creating and implementing a regional multicausality incident (MCI) plan. TSE Branch Update	Melissa Ball shared 67 designations from 32 out of 46 facilities have been approved which makes up 70 percent of Idaho facilities who hold one or more TSE designation, and five EMS agencies have been designated. The TSE Branch has scheduled several site surveys for this fall with a few more pending. The TSE Branch and EMSC Program will be attending conferences again as vendors to educate healthcare providers on time sensitive emergencies and pediatric care. As well, the TSE Branch and EMSC Program will be posting on their Facebook pages again on related education, stories, designations, etc.
EMSC Program Update	Stacy Rodgers shared at the July EMSC Advisory Committee continues to create criteria for the Prehospital Readiness Recognition Program that will roll out early next year. As well, the EMSC Advisory Committee added new criteria for the Hospital Readiness Recognition Program based on the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) requirements and Pediatric Readiness Recognition Programs Collaborative (PRRPC) recommendations. Lastly, the National Pediatric Readiness Project Assessment (NPRP) will open in March 2026.
TSE Designation Certificate Designs	The Idaho TSE Council provided feedback on propose new designs for the TSE Designation Certificate. The TSE Council will approve the final design at the September TSE Council Meeting.

Idaho TSE Brain Injury Guidelines	Dr. Parker Fillmore presented the final drafted Idaho TSE Brain Injury Guidelines. The Idaho TSE Council approved the new guidelines including their recommended revisions for clarity purposes.
